Sicily is a region in **southern** Italy. It is a triangle-shaped island **surrounded by** the Mediterranean Sea.

Sicily has three main **mountain ranges**: Peloritani, Nebrodi and Madonie.

Its main rivers are Simeto and Alcantara which **flow into** Ionio Sea, Salso, Platani and Belice which flow into Sicily Channel and Torto which flows into Tirreno Sea. They are not very long.

Sicily's main city is Palermo. **It is famous for** its history and art all over the world and **it is rich in** ancient monuments like the Arab-Norman Cathedral.

The Sicilian **flag** has two colours: red and yellow.

The climate is **mild**. Summers are hot and dry while winters are usually mild or cold in the mountains.
